**CESS sell another 4 MW Peter Brotherhood
Steam Turbine to Uruguay**

Head-quartered in Stromness in the Orkney Islands, Combustion, Energy and Steam Specialists Ltd. (CESS) has recently been successful in the sale of a 4 MW Peter Brotherhood steam turbine from a cancelled project in Australia to Uruguay in South America.

Combustion, Energy & Steam Specialists Ltd have to date been instrumental in the sale of 58 gas turbines (totaling over 2064 MW), 33 steam turbines (891 MW), 90 diesel/gas engines (207 MW), and 45 transformers (total 616 MW). CESS has now reached an impressive total of over 34,085 MW of valuation experience in the past nine years and these valuations have included:

- 225 gas turbines totaling over 10,523 MW (including Allison, Rolls Royce, GE, Solar, Pratt & Whitney, Fiat, Ruston, Westinghouse, Siemens & ABB/Alstom)
- 141 steam turbines totaling 14,662 MW (including AEG, ABB, Ansaldo, Blohm & Voss, Elliott, Fuji, GE, Westinghouse, Siemens, Terry, Mitsubishi, Parsons, Stal, Allen, KKK, Peter Brotherhood, AEI/EE, Worthington, Daniel Adamson, & Alstom)
- 386 diesels totaling over 1421 MW (including Pielstick, Polar, MTU, MWM Deutz, Mirrlees, Superior, Allen, MAN/B&W, Wartsila NSD, Sulzer, Ruston, Cummins, Cat, MAK, Ulstein)
- 29 Power Barges, totaling over 1,537 MW (including Victoria 1, 2, 3, 5, Dura 3 + 4, etc.)

CESS have now sold equipment or provided manpower into Saudi Arabia, Dubai, Afghanistan, Kuwait, South Africa, Botswana, Swaziland, Tanzania, Malawi, Kenya, Dominican Republic, USA, Bolivia, Uruguay, Italy, Germany, Finland, Poland, Ecuador, Eire, Scotland, England, Malaysia, Philippines, China, New Zealand, Australia, Indonesia, Thailand, Vietnam, Singapore, Cayman Islands, Nigeria, India and Brunei.

Since first established in January 1995 CESS has contributed over £4.7 M to the Orkney economy and now employs 11 staff in their Stromness office:

In 2007 CESS also concluded the sale of a 30 MW steam turbine from Poland to the Tata Group in India, and the sale of the 34 MW steam turbine from Sita Tyre Recycling plant in Wolverhampton to British Gas for conversion to combined cycle of their 3 Tornado gas turbines at Milford Haven refinery in S Wales.

As Mike Craigie, CESS's Managing Director explains: *"CESS has now developed into a self-sustaining company which can compete with the best Companies in the World on equipment valuation, marketing, decommissioning, dismantling and relocation, and either of these qualities can take precedence in terms of an equipment owner's (seller) requirements or the end-user or client's needs..*

When we first started out in 1995, many owners of surplus equipment had no idea what their equipment was worth, and our main aim is to free up such equipment by setting realistic targets for sale and then circulating information on the plant availability.

Unlike most independent appraisers, we are willing to stand by our valuations and undertake to find buyers for such plant, so it's more of an added value ("cradle to grave") service which we can provide.

CESS now generate around 200 enquiries every month, with many of these coming from past clients, referrals, or any of our 48 shareholders Worldwide. Many equipment buyers are not aware of the extent and nature of equipment that we can make available and a high percentage of the plant we sell has either been unused, or has very low hours."

CESS now has investors in 38 countries, and is still actively looking to expand their equity base with regional shareholders whose expertise (or geographical support) can help to strengthen the CESS portfolio of related services, and/or by acting as local agents. Since their reactivation in 1995, CESS has handled over 13,500 enquiries.

The Company recently exhibited at the Power-Gen Exhibition in New Orleans and will this year be at Power-Gen in Milan, Kuala Lumpur & Orlando and also at CEPSI in Macau.
